Su • Jun 25

Spokane, Washington: Arrive in Spokane today (make flight arrangements on your own) and transfer by shuttle to the Red Lion Hotel. Here, you'll be greeted by your Western Leisure tour director who will advise you on checking in and how to spend your free time. In the evening, celebrate the first day of summer during a Welcome Dinner with your fellow travelers.

Mo • Jun 26

Wallace, Idaho & Missoula, Montana: This morning, travel east into Idaho, skirting the banks of Lake Coeur D' Alene en route to Wallace - the historic Silver Capital of the World. Enjoy a Sierra Silver Mine tour led by an experienced miner who will explain both the modern and historical techniques of mining silver, lead and zinc. Sit down to lunch at the historic Jameson Hotel, then, continue to the Smokejumpers Base Aerial Fire Depot near Missoula, Montana. Listen as Forest Service Smokejumpers offer firsthand accounts of their courageous firefighting missions. Check in for an overnight stay at the Best Western Grant Creek Inn, with dinner on your own.

Tu • Jun 27

Big Fork/Flathead River and Glacier National Park: Following breakfast, travel to the Flathead Indian Reservation with a stop at the historic St. Ignatius Mission. From there, continue north for your first taste of Glacier Country as you enjoy a

Scenic Float Trip on the Flathead River. Once ashore, we'll proceed into the park, checking in for a two-night stay at the Many Glacier Hotel. This beautiful Swiss-style lodge was constructed in 1915 and is now a National Historic Landmark. The old-world style accommodations offer modest amenities, providing a one-of-a kind, National Park lodging experience. Tonight's dinner is at the hotel.

We • Jun 28

Many Glacier Hotel: This morning's highlights include relaxing cruises on both Swiftcurrent Lake and nearby Lake Josephine. Spend the rest of your day enjoying the amenities of the Many Glacier Lodge, or choose from a wide selection of optional excursions and activities - such as hiking, horseback riding, fishing, a jeep tour or canoeing.

Going to the Sun Road: Today, you'll experience the world famous "Going to the Sun Road." Travel to beautiful St. Mary Valley, where you'll board vintage Red Jammer Touring Cars for a 52-mile drive that crests the Continental Divide at Logan Pass and descends through majestic mountains and deep valley floors.
